Red Bull Media House's latest documentary provides an insightful look into the mind of the world's best skier, Mikaela Shiffrin.

The 2018 film “Peak Season” follows Mikaela as she prepares for Olympic competition, all the while covering her roots, her winning mental game, and what she looks forward to next in the world of skiing. Let's just say those medals aren't going to win themselves.

Mikaela became the youngest slalom champion in Olympic history by winning Gold at the 2014 Winter Olympics in Sochi, Russia at the age of 18. She won Gold again in the giant slalom at the 2018 Winter Olympics in South Korea. She also won Silver in the combined event.

Red Bull Media House released “Peak Season” just before the winter Olympic Games in Pyeongchang, South Korea.

The Warren Miller Award is for Modern Media Coverage of Skiing. This award is given for outstanding service to skiing by cinematographers, photographers, radio or television broadcasters.
