Reno Welcomes the 81st Annual Far West Ski Association Convention

Reno, Nevada (May 21, 2013) - The Far West Ski Association (FWSA) invites the community to participate in its 81st Annual Convention to be held at the Grand Sierra Resort and Casino, June 6-9, 2013. The Far West Ski Association is a volunteer, non-profit organization representing 180 affiliated ski clubs located throughout 11 regional councils in 13 western states.
