U.S. Ski and Snowboard Hall of Fame: The US Ski and Snowboard Hall of Fame enshrined seven new legends to the Hall of Fame - Class of 2015 – on Friday, September 16, 2016, in **Ishpeming, Michigan**. A reception announcing this newest group of Honored Members was held at the Limelight Hotel in **Aspen** last October 23rd, 2015. Those inducted are: freestyle skiing world champions *Genia Fuller* and *Bob Salerno*; longtime ski industry leader *David Ingemie*, veteran magazine publisher *Henry Kaiser*, Olympic snowboarding medalist *Chris Klug*; adaptive skiing innovator *Jim Martinson*, and the late *Edgar Stern* who developed Deer Valley Resort. Prior to the enshrinement, a new statue, honoring ski jumpers, was unveiled. The statue is duly named "*Passion to Fly*". Stop to take a look when you find yourself in Ishpeming.

Ski Train Returns to Colorado: The Ski Train is back! After an 8-year absence, the *Colorado Ski Train* will run once again. Beginning January 7, 2017, Amtrak will be leaving Denver's Union Station each weekend morning at 7 am, and arriving at **Winter Park Mountain Resort** at 9 am.
