SCHOLARSHIPS

Far West awards Athletic Scholarships to developing Alpine ski racers participating in programs within the Far West geographic region.

Scholarships assist athletes who are committed to pursuing a competitive Alpine racing program. Scholarship funds are used to offset training expenses and competition entrance fees.
