SNOWSTORM IN AFRICA: A snowstorm dumped more than 3" snow at Afriski Mountain Resort, in Lesotho, southern Africa in recent days. The ski area now has a base of 16". While we would all normally scoff at a mere 3" of snow, this is a BIG deal in Africa. Afriski is the only ski area in Lesotho, but one of 3 in southern Africa. The resort can accommodate about 320 people and offers a one-kilometer ski slope, and beginner's slope, and operates during the winter months (June–August). Afriski also operates in the summer months and offers a variety of activities, from mountain biking, guided Enduro motorbike trips, paintball, hiking, trail running, and more.

PARK CITY UPGRADE PLANS BLOCKED: The Park City Planning Commission blocked plans for the mountain to upgrade their 6-pack and 8-pack chairs, planned to be completed for the 2022-2023 ski season. The move was being done to eliminate the long lift lines, currently at those 2 chairs, and being able to move people quicker, and more easily up the mountain. The city cited that the proposed lifts were not consistent with the 1998 agreement that governs the resort. More review will be required in order for the changes to go forward.
