MT. HOOD MEADOWS JOINS INDY PASS: The Indy Pass will now include Mt. Hood Meadows, in Oregon. This resort is Indy's largest resort by skier volume, and it brings the number of Indy partners to 105 for the 2022-2023 Season. Other recent additions include Black Mountain of Maine; Meadowlark, Wyoming; and Aomori Spring, Japan as full downhill partners

TOP 13 LARGEST SKI RESORTS ON EARTH: Last month the Flash reported the Top Ten SMALL Ski Resorts. Now, let's turn the tables and list the top 13 LARGEST Ski Resorts on earth. Only ONE is in the U.S. From largest to smallest: Les Trois Vallees, France (600 km), Sella Ronda, Italy (500 km), Alpe d'Huze & Les Deux Alpes, France (475 km), Paradiski, France (425 km), Four Vallees, Switzerland (412 km), Milky Way, France/Italy (400 km), Matterhorn Ski Paradise, Switzerland/Italy (360 km), Saalbach, Austria (345 km), Les Sybelles, France (310 km), Arlberg Ski Area, Austria (305 km), Val d'Isere/Tignes, France (300 km), Park City, Utah (265 km), and Whistler/Blackcomb, B.C. (253 km). How many of these areas have YOU skied?

Lyford*, near Christ Church, recently had to close due to TOO MUCH snow....too much snow on the roads, poor visibility, and chairs having to be dug out. On the other side of this, Austria's *Mölltaler Gletscher* and *Val d'Isère* had to suspend summer operations, as did the Italian Glacier, *Passo Stelvio*.
