Your four-day weekend will keep you busy with all that is planned, including: discussions on programs in public affairs, skier safety, ski heritage, athletic scholarships, racing, communications, travel, council development, ski industry and community outreach. The event will be hosted by the *Bay Area Snow Sports Council and Sierra League and Council*.
