Stein Ericksen Honored at New Museum: The Alf Engen Ski Museum, located inside the Utah Olympic Park in Park City, has unveiled an exhibit filled with artifacts loaned by Stein Eriksen's son Bjorn Eriksen, honoring the life of late ski legend. "Stein Eriksen has been synonymous with skiing style and elegance for more than half a century," said David Vandehei, chairman of the Ski Museum board of directors. "The first alpine skier to win triple gold at a world championship, an Olympic Gold Medalist and ambassador and father of freestyle skiing, Eriksen parlayed all that he knew and loved about the sport into an incredible career that spanned almost six decades and changed the face of alpine skiing worldwide.

End Coming Near for K2, Marmot, and Other Skis: Newell Brands has announced the company's intention to sell or abandon its entire collection of winter sports brands by January 1, 2017, including K2, Völkl, Marker, Full-Tilt, Marmot, Line Skis and Ride Snowboards. The company has given itself only a few months to sell its portfolio of Winter Sports businesses within its Outdoor Solutions Segment, including brands such as Coleman, AeroBed and Abu Garcia, which Newell will retain. If K2 or Marmot is one of your favorite brands, you'd better buy them now while you still can!

Snowmass Base Village Sold: East West Partners, a partner of Aspen Skiing Company (ASC), announced that they have formed a joint venture to acquire the Snowmass Base Village project. The acquisition includes all remaining development parcels, all commercial spaces in Base Village, the Snowmass Hospitality property management company and the Viceroy Hotel. including the unsold condominium units within the hotel. ASC will purchase the Limelight Hotel and 4 Mountain Sports space when they are complete, and are committed to operating both. The transaction is expected to be completed by the end of 2016.

Epic Pass Adds Ski Resorts in France, Italy, Switzerland and Austria. Vail Resorts has added Les 3 Vallées, Paradiski and Tignes-Val d'Isere in France, Skirama Dolomiti Adamello Brenta in Italy, 4 Vallees in Switzerland, and Arlberg in Austria to the 2016-2017 lineup of the Epic Pass. This pass offers unlimited, unrestricted skiing access at the company's 13 ski resorts in the U.S. and Australia.
