WHO & WHAT'S NEW FOR 2015-2016

Happy 50th Birthday Whistler: Originally opened for skiing in the winter of 1966, Whistler Blackcomb is kicking off it's 50th Anniversary season with 50 Years of Going Beyond, a movie five decades in the making. Check out the official movie trailers: www.youtube.com/watch?v UigSB4TLWI4.

Brighton is 80 Years Old: Brighton, near Salt Lake City, celebrates it's 80th year in business this coming season. Located just 35 minutes from the SLC airport, Brighton is Utah's only resort that serves 100 percent of it's terrain via high-speed lifts. Happy birthday, *Brighton*.

Cherry Peak Opens in Utah: Utah's newest ski area, Cherry Peak Resort, is set to open this winter, after a false start last year. Located in Northern Utah, near the Idaho border, it is just 15 miles from the city of Logan. Cherry Peak features three triple chairlifts, a comprehensive snowmaking infrastructure, and a 1.25 mile-long run. Come see what all they have to offer.

Toll Roads for Colorado: Something new this year on *I-70*, according to the Colorado Department of Transportation will be a variable toll lane in operation along a key 13-mile stretch of eastbound *I-70* in time for this winter, in an effort to lessen snarled traffic on busy ski weekends. Toll prices will vary, depending on time of day and congestion levels, and are expected to run from \$3 at initial opening when traffic starts building, (usually between 7:30 a.m. and 10 a.m.), to encourage toll lane usage, up to \$30 during peak periods. Current pricing will be displayed at the beginning of the toll lane and online at cotrip.org. Tolls will be paid via an ExpressToll transponder. For those without a transponder, they will be billed a higher rate as license plate numbers are captured.

Big White Opens New Day Lodge: Big White's new Black Forest Lodge is scheduled to open this December, and will operate daily from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. The lodge will feature a guick-service menu including specialty sandwiches, house-made soups and fresh baked pastries, with seating for 150 just steps away from the Black Forest chairlift. Local craft beers or glasses of Okanagan wines will be served. A modern, sophisticated space will feature floor-to-ceiling windows for breathtaking, panoramic views of the Monashee and Selkirk mountain ranges.

Brundage Mountain Earns "Top Ten" Awards: Kudos to Brundage Mountain! Their tag line, "Best Snow in Idaho", has been proven. Readers of Ski Magazine voted Brundage onto three "Top Ten" lists in this year's readers survey, ranking it #9 in the west for Families, #10 for Value and #10 for Snow. The crew at Brundage Mountain are very proud of their awards. Being a smaller mountain than the others on the list, they have gotten noticed without having the hoards of visitors as some of the other finalists see. If you haven't been there, go check them out....for the value, for the families, for the snow.
