Far West Board Meets: The Far West Ski Association (FWSA) conducted its winter Board of Directors meeting December 5-7, 2014 at The Cliffs Lodge located in Snowbird Ski and Summer Resort, Utah. Vail Resorts Details Plan in Utah: Vail Resorts has announced details of the company's planned upgrades to Park City Mountain Resort for the 2015-16 ski season that will create the nation's largest single ski resort in Utah. The plan is one of the largest capital development programs in U.S. ski industry history. The key component of the plan will, for the first time. connect Park City with nearby Canyons Resort, creating the largest single ski area in the country with more than 7,300 acres of skiable terrain.

Deer Valley Proposes Gondola: Once Vail Resorts completes its planned connection of Park City Mountain Resort (PCMR) and Canyons Resort this summer, Park City will become a tworesort ski town. PCMR already has the Town Lift to carry skiers to the slopes from Park City's historic downtown district. Now, Deer Valley Resort is proposing to move forward on a ski lift link of its own to bring its guests to the heart of the Utah

Far West Ski Foundation Supports Vail Veteran's Program: Far West has been a supporter of the Vail Veteran's Program for some time. In paying tribute to so many veterans this past Veteran's Day, we heard from Brigadier General Pete Dawkins (U.S. Army, retired) and his wife Judy: "Of all the wounded warrior-type undertakings, the Vail Veterans Program is unique. Begun 11 years ago, it concentrates on two specific features. First, to show the individuals that, despite the limitations of their injuries, they can still lead active, energetic lives. Many arrive discouraged and despondent, but find to their astonishment that new avenues of activity they never dreamed of are available to them. Second, the Vail Veterans Program approach makes a special effort to include and involve husbands, wives, kids, parents, and

caregivers. What is sometimes missed is the understanding of just how much families benefit from being a part of it all, and how powerful the reassurance and encouragement is that comes from the collective spirit of family."

We have made grants this month to the Vail Veterans Program and the DREAM Adaptive Recreation. We need to continue our support of on-snow rehabilitation using adaptive techniques and our support to women's ski jumping. (WSJ has inaugurated its Fly Girls program to bring young girls up in the program, following their presence at Sochi). We have not made a grant for jumping yet this year. This is our most immediate campaign challenge. We have only two weeks left in this calendar year.
