**BODE MILLER LAUNCHES PEAK SKI COMPANY:** Bode Miller is launching a new venture, *Peak Ski Company*, a direct-to-consumer ski brand leading with a line of six all-mountain skis designed for skiers of all abilities. Miller is joined by co-founder Andy Wirth, most recently the president and CEO of Squaw Valley Ski Holdings until 2018, who will serve as the brand's CEO. His latest project began a little over a year ago with the intense focus on developing the highest performance skis possible, designed for all skiers on every part of the mountain.

**WINTER PARKS NEW 'MASTER PLAN'**: A proposed 10-to-15-year master development plan for *Winter Park Resort*, Colo., includes a series of gondolas that would connect downtown Winter Park to the Winter Park Resort village, among a variety of other elements that include new and replacement lifts, expanded terrain, new facilities, and more. The town connection would include a 10-person gondola that would carry guests from downtown Winter Park up to the Copper Creek Summit, and another eight-person gondola would connect from there to the resort village. The development plan calls for the total number of lifts to increase from 23 to 29. An additional 358 acres of skiable terrain will be developed. The new terrain area will include new base and summit lodges.

**VAIL RESORT AND SUGARBUSH RESORT CEO'S TO BE RECOGNIZED:** Win Smith and Rob Katz will receive the 2022 National Ski Areas Association (NSAA) Lifetime Achievement and Industry Impact Awards, respectively, on Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup>, at the 60<sup>th</sup> Annual NSAA Convention in Nashville. Smith owned Sugarbush for more than 19 years before selling the resort to Alterra Mountain Company in January 2020. After 15 years as CEO of Vail Resorts, Katz stepped down in November 2021 and assumed the role of executive chairperson.
